Munich

Dear Steve,

I received your telegram this afternoon but we will be in Italy tomorrow and traveling down to Naples as fast as we can since we both want to get back and rest up.

I'm sorry I missed you in Munich, I got here the night of the 13th I think. I really like Munich, with all its beer houses. I drank one liter of beer last night and it didn't even affect me at all. I thought of you when I was there having a good time, but I would have had a better time if you had been there. You should come up here and make the beer hall rounds, you really would fall in love with Munich. I went to three here and really had a good time.

When Chuck sent my bag he didn't take the bag through customs in Grenoble so the bag is at one of the French borders and I can't get it. Boy, am I mad! In Frankfurt I went to three railroad stations and to every warehouse in Frankfurt looking for my bag until the customs office was at the border. I haven't heard from Chuck so I'm still not sure if he sent it. If he sent it, it is ~~in~~ the French border.

My train ride up to Oslo was very nice, I met some people who spoke English and we talked for a long time to keep from becoming bored. From Frankfurt to Hamburg was an Express train, from Ham. to Copenhagen was express and from Coph. to Oslo was also express. I only had to wait ten minutes in Hamburg and I had to wait almost five in Coph. I was very lucky and had excellent connections. My mother called the morning of the 10th about 4:00 AM to

find out how I was but I didn't get to talk to her. I was asleep but Miss Skaliski did.

Yesterday I got a letter from Mom, she said her flight was changed and before she got to New York she got on a Jet from Washington to Rome and jet from Rome to Naples and was in Naples the morning of the second. I waited in Frankfurt until the jet for her and the boy but neither came but I met a lot of real nice people. When I was trying to find my bag the Germans were so nice and they all did so much to help me. I don't know what I would have done without some nice people stuck around and about.

Tomorrow I'll be in Italy and on my way home to Naples. Will it ever be hot here! It was so hot in Munich I could hardly stand the heat. That's hard to believe for Germany.

Have you met a traveling companions yet? That shouldn't be hard to find one. I've met about ten boys who are traveling but I don't guess that would do for you.

I went to Dachau Wednesday. It was interesting and very depressing. I still have a headache from being depressed after going there, but I'm glad I went but once is enough for me.

I wish I could have met you in Munich but I'll see you in New York if you still want to see me next summer. That won't be long off.

I really dread going back to school even though I will be a senior. I hate school and I know how slow this next year will pass for me. I hate it so much I want to cry every time I think of school and the kids in Naples.

I finally broke down and bought another pen but this one is a cheap one because if I buy a cheap one I won't lose it.

The car's all ready to go so I guess I have to go with the car since I only have about ten dollars left to get back to Naples with.
